In my Still Life series I've arranged objects as another way of celebrating the intrinsic humor and delight in the ordinary.

Alan Rabold has been working as a photographer and teacher in Colorado for many years. His work is in the permanent collections of the Denver Art Museum and the Amoco Corp. Fine Arts Collection. He has had one-man shows at Oxford University in the UK, the Boulder Dairy Center for the Arts and the NCAR Gallery in Boulder, Colorado. He has also shown at the Denver Art Museum, the Mizel Museum, Gallery Sink and Core Art Space in Denver, Colorado as well as the University of Colorado Galleries and the Boulder Museum of Contemporary Art. He resides in Boulder, Colorado.










